The launch of AIDA marks the IEO's drive to stay ahead of the digital curve and to support UNDP's role as a trusted development partner in this time of rapid change. Using the designated search portal, AIDA aims to make sure the information everyone in UNDP needs to make informed decisions is just a click away.

AIDA is a machine learning model that extracts key sections from evaluation reports through a web portal, accessed with a simple query. It supports development professionals search for information in a smart, efficient and innovative way. Findings and recommendations are tailored to the user's area of interest through a series of intelligent filters including geographical and thematic areas.

AIDA was developed by the UNDP Independent Evaluation Office, in partnership with UNDP Information & Technology Management with the support of the United Nations International Computing Centre (UNICC) and Amazon Web Services.
