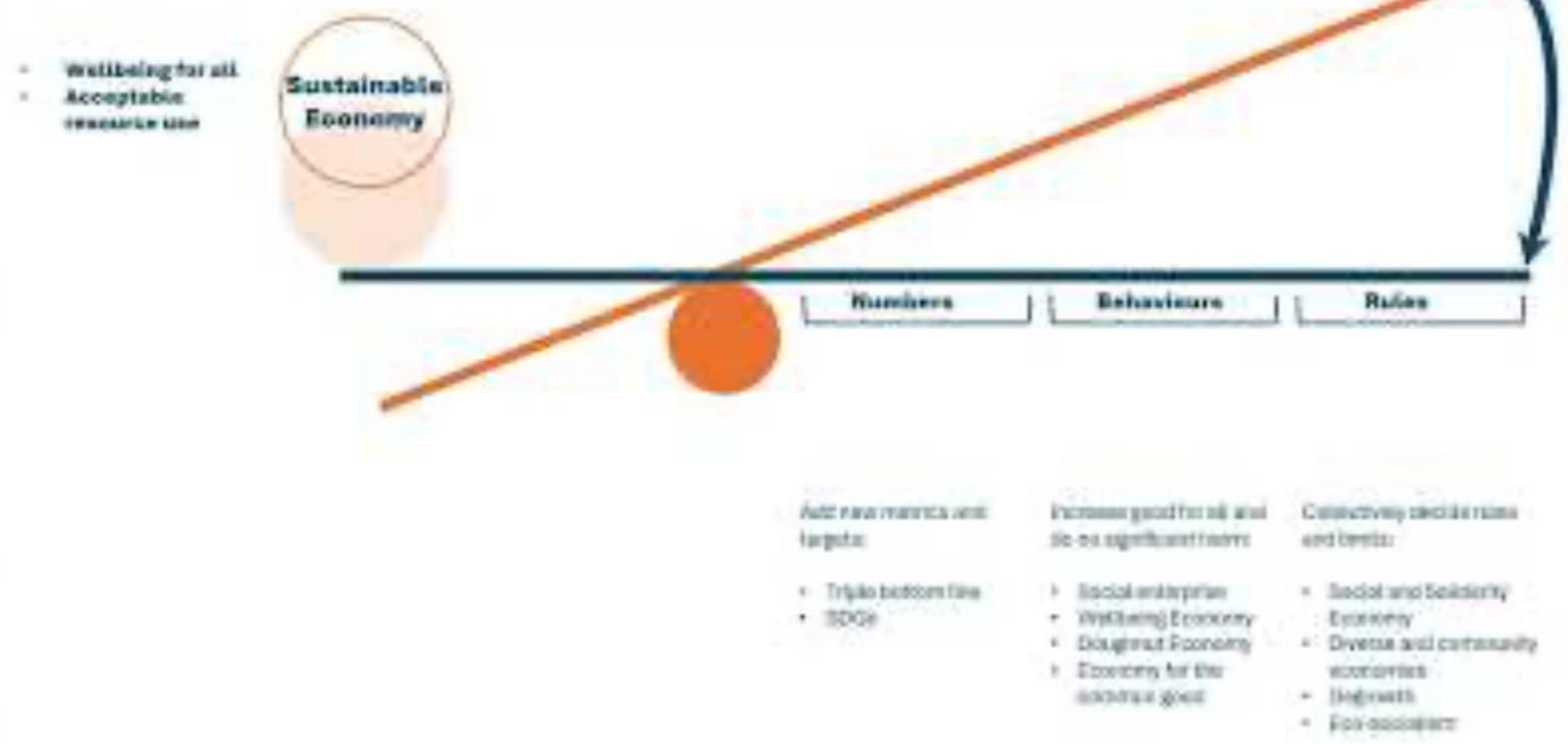


Conceptual framework



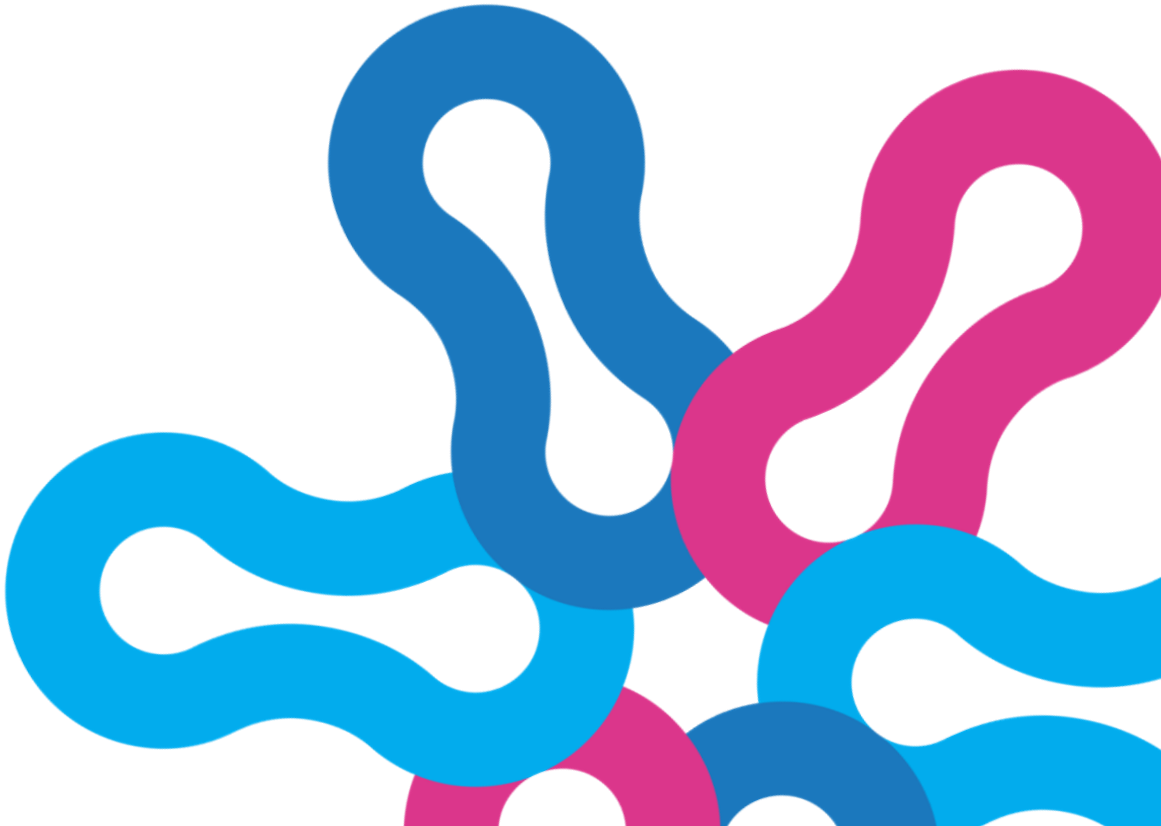
Social ecological framework (1:36 - 4:28)

How do movements leverage change towards sustainability?

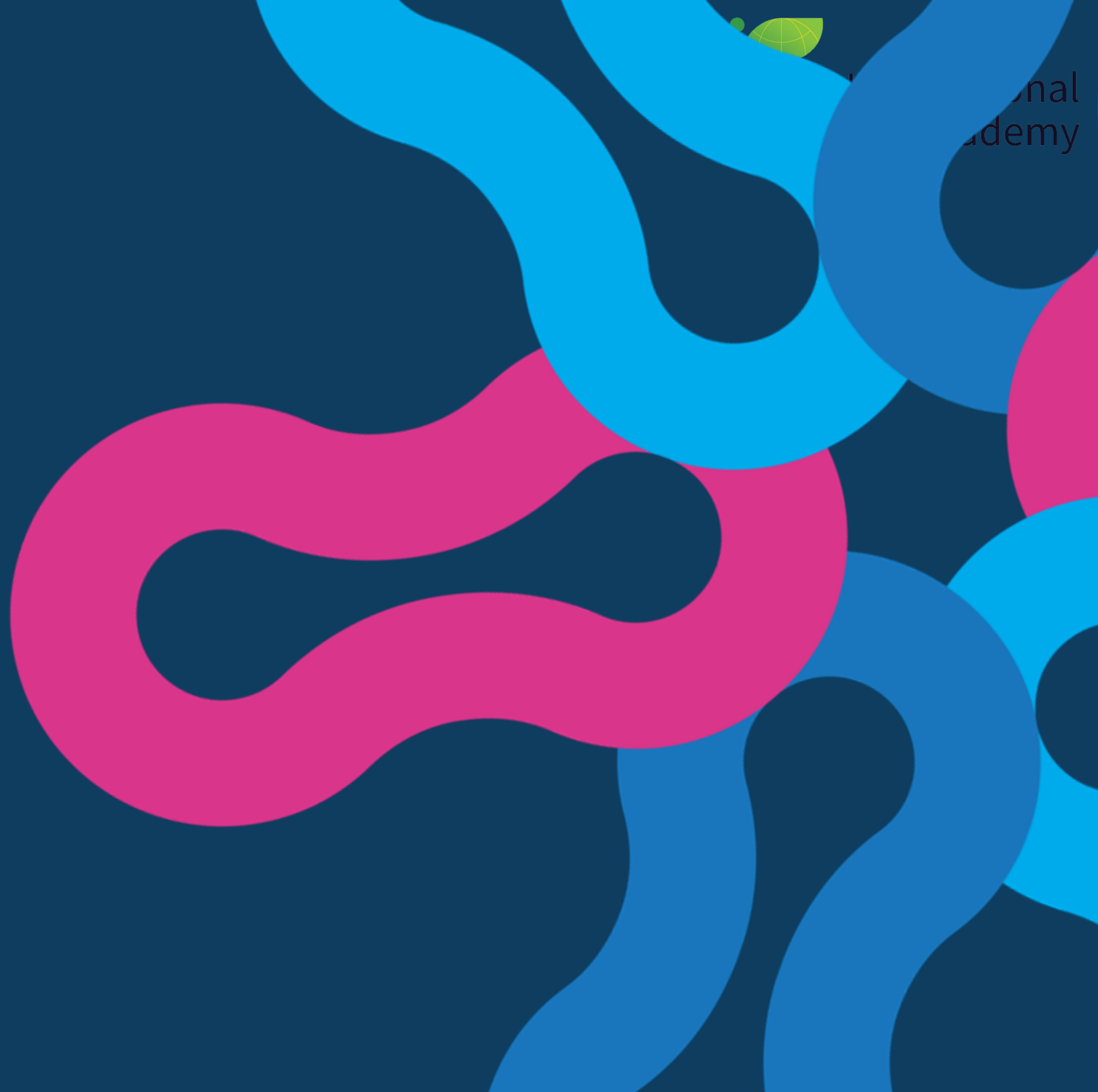
